- Community Resource Navigators at multiple locations.
- Access emergency housing, food, clothing, household furnishings and other resources.
- Assistance with applications for public assistance, SNAP, SSI/SSDI, and HEAP and advocacy with DSS and National Grid.
- Mediate disputes between tenant and landlord.

Employment Services

- Career Readiness Programs.
- Training to re-enter the workforce/change careers.
- Staff assisted job search, job retention, referrals, and ongoing case management for graduates.
- Reentry Employment Opporunities.

Early Learning Programs

- Comprehensive education for children birth to five years old.
- Specialized services, including: health, nutrition, mental health, occupational therapy, physical therapy, and family development.
- Early Head Start-Child Care
 Partnerships that improve the quality of existing child care programs and broaden access to high-quality care for low-income infants and toddlers.
- Operates three early learning centers for pre-school aged children.
- Project LAUNCH addresses the physical, emotional, cognitive, social, and behavioral aspects of development in children ages birth to 21.

Housing Programs
